### Eligibility requirements

Eligible types of businesses may include: retail, light industrial, food service, light manufacturing, office buildings, storage and warehouse facilities, special districts, nonprofits and municipalities. The program is designed to address the needs of small commercial customers with an energy demand of 0–200 kW.

The program covers many energy efficiency measures including:

### Lighting

- Select LED Technologies
- High Performance T8/T5 Retrofits
- High Bay Replacements
- Compact Fluorescent Lamps
- Induction Lighting
- Exterior Lighting

### Refrigeration

- ECM for Walk-In Evaporator Fan
- ECM for Walk-In Evaporator Fan with Controller
- Evaporator Fan Control
- Automatic door closer on walk-in cooler or freezer doors
- Vending Machine Controller
- Anti-Sweat Heater (ASH) Controls

## Program support from beginning to end

To enroll in the Energy Watch Program, please contact your local Energy Watch to schedule a meeting in which a program representative will explain the process in further detail and determine how the Energy Watch Program can best serve your needs.

If you decide to participate, the process is as follows:

1. You sign an access agreement and complete a no-cost, no-obligation energy survey.
2. The project manager runs the findings from the survey through evaluation software and provides a report summarizing:
  - Recommended measures.
  - Estimated project cost.
  - Incentive levels.
  - Estimated energy and cost savings.
  - Simple payback and estimated greenhouse gas (GHG) reduction.
3. You sign a Program Participation Agreement form for the measures you decide to implement. You will receive referrals to qualified electrical contractors.
4. TEAA provides technical support, handles rebate paperwork, and gives project oversight as contractors complete the work.
5. TEAA conducts a post-installation verification survey to confirm that the measures have been installed properly and to assure customer satisfaction.
6. Energy Watch can refer you to additional programs offered by PG&E, or to other vendors, and can also assist you in your pursuit of Green Business Certification.

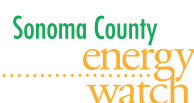
